SAVING FOR RETIREMENT

All benefited employees at UVA participate in a mandatory retirement plan, but did you know you can boost your retirement savings and receive matching funds from UVA? Don't leave money on the table!

Saving for retirement is crucial for several reasons: it helps provide you with Financial Security, it helps maintain your lifestyle in retirement, and it helps you prepare for rising costs that you really can't control like inflation and Healthcare.

By saving as much as you can for retirement during your working years, you prepare yourself to handle these challenges and ensure comfortable and a secure future. You might be starting small, but funds in your account can really build up over time.

If you are an academic employee in the optional retirement plan or VRS plan one or two, you can enroll in the 403b anytime through Workday. You will receive a 50% cash match on the funds you contribute up to \$40 a month--putting [this] in real terms--if you contribute \$80 a month, you'll receive another \$40 from UVA.

University Medical Center team members can also save in the UVA 403b and enroll in Workday; team members in the medical center retirement plan receive a 50% cash match on what [they] contribute up to 4% of [their] salary. This means if you contribute 4% of your salary per pay period, you'll receive a cash match from UVA of 2%.

Academic employees and the VRS hybrid plan can save in the voluntary cash match hybrid plan. You can enroll in the hybrid cash match plan through VRS' retirement savings vendor. Employees can contribute up to 4% of their salary and receive a cash match of 2.5%.

All UVA employees can save up to the IRS limit in the UVA 403b and 457 each year. The IRS will announce these limits every fall.
