Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is my cost-share for the hearing exam when using my UVA Health Plan and seeing an Audiologist?

When seeing an in-network audiologist your cost per plan would be;

Basic Health: Deductible & 20% Coinsurance

Value Health: \$40 Copay

Choice Health: Deductible & 15% Coinsurance

2. What is my cost-share for hearing aids?

Aetna covers hearing aids up to \$1,200 every 48 months. This is a maximum amount that includes your cost share and Aetna's.

Scenario: Value Health \$800 Deductible + 20% coinsurance. Assuming no deductible has been met.

Hearing aid cost \$2,000. Member cost is \$800 deductible + \$240 (20%) coinsurance. Member cost is \$1,040. Aetna will pay \$160 total allowed \$1,200. Any amount over \$1,200 is additional member responsibility.

Basic Health EE only \$2,000 Deductible + 20% coinsurance. Assuming no deductible has been met.

Dual Hearing aids cost \$4,000. Member costs is \$1,200 deductible. Aetna will may zero cost. Member is responsible for the \$1,200 deductible and remaining balance of \$2,800.

3. What is the difference between using the New Hearing benefit within the UVA Health Plan or using a discount program?

UVA Health Plan New Hearing benefit covers hearing exams performed by an audiologist with appropriate cost share and hearing aids up to \$1,200 every 48 months, if medically necessary.

The discount program provides exams and hearing aids at a discounted rate. The costs you pay for this program are not calculated towards your health plan accumulators such as your deductible or out-of-pocket maximum.

4. If the audiologist determines I need hearing aids, can I take the script to another location to use my UVA Health Plan hearing coverage?

Yes, you can take the script for hearing aids to another location. If you use an out-of-network provider, you will pay for the hearing aids upfront and submit the receipt to Aetna for reimbursement at the out-of-network cost share. If you choose to obtain the hearing aids from the audiologist who completed the exam, the provider will submit the claim to Aetna and will be applied towards the in-network cost share.

5. How do I find an audiologist in-network?
